

# Follow up-course (English version)

Basic course completed, now what?

You have completed the basic course, now what? I've heard that question many times. To continue in photography, I therefore made the follow-up course. The principle is simple: we do 5 different workshops. All these workshops contain a specific subject of photography. The workshops are always different and sometimes also topical (think of the Eindhoven marathon, for example).

In addition to these workshops, you will receive an assignment during the course that you can do in your own time. This assignment is aimed at a specific learning goal (for example, better lighting). Let's call this the common thread. All assignments and learning objectives are aimed at the level of the group. In addition, I take into account the individual level. You will receive an extensive briefing prior to each workshop.

For workshops you can think of sports (movement), macro, evening light, architecture, model (whether or not in the studio), street photography, landscape and sometimes also music. In any case, it is always a varied program. The goal is to take you further.

After each workshop there is a discussion lesson. You bring the most interesting printed photos and we discuss them together. You learn to think about a photo and look together with the other photographers at which learning points belong to a photo. In my opinion you can learn from a good photo... We give each other feedback, but always in a positive way. We respect each other's opinions and help each other improve and grow in photography. Ultimately, there is the judgment of me (Maurits van Hout) as a teacher.

What do you have to be able to do?

After the basic course you should be able to operate your camera. You need to know the basics of photography, think of exposures, depth of field and composition. You are also enthusiastic and enjoy working together in a small group.

Why should you do this course?

You increase your knowledge and experience. You improve your camera technique. You see different facets of photography and discover what suits you. You are actively engaged in the best hobby there is for 10 evenings and that in a cozy group. The conversations really take you further with your photography!
